ADOPT-A-PARK PROGRAM



Bayport is looking for community members to participate in a new program to assist the city with general

park cleanup and special projects. Neighborhood organizations, civic and church groups, scout troops, businesses, schools, families, and individuals are invited to partner with the city to improve the environment and quality of life in Bayport through enhanced park grounds.

The goal of the Adopt-A-Park program is to maintain a cleaner and healthier environment for our community, while allowing the city to better conserve and redirect its resources!

The program will not be used in place of the city's regular park maintenance.

Instead, the Adopt-A-Park program is designed to supplement current services and increase citizen awareness and pride in our parks. Clean, litter-free parks display civic pride and accountability!



BAYPORT PARKS AND GARDENS



Bayport has four amazing parks, Barker's Alps, Lakeside, Perro, and Village Green. Combined, these parks

offer exceptional amenities for residents to enjoy, such as a swimming beach, picnic shelters, hiking trails, softball fields, tennis courts, ice skating rinks, and playground equipment.

The city also features flower gardens and landscaped areas at the Public Library and City Hall, and rain gardens at Lakeside and Barker's Alps Parks.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Groups who wish to participate in the Adopt-A-Park program must agree to a one year commitment to maintaining a designated park, garden, or grounds or completion of a specific park project. Planting,



weeding, and general cleanup are a few of the activities volunteers can perform. The city will work with groups to

identify projects that fit the desires and abilities of the volunteers, as well as the needs of the city. Input from groups on identifying other needs and developing plans for park areas are welcome.

Groups must designate a leader to serve as the primary liaison to the city. The group leader will be responsible for helping identify potential projects, and scheduling volunteers to complete the work. The group leader will also be responsible for reporting progress to the city and notifying the city of any maintenance or equipment needs. Timely and consistent reports will enable the city staff to maintain, restore, and improve park areas.
