PET OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Obtain an annual city pet license and affix license tag to pet collar
- Control pet by leash in city parks, streets, open space areas, and public property
- Have a method to pick-up and properly dispose of all fecal matter created by pet on public and private property
- Control pet to prevent excessive noise, interference with pedestrians, other pets, or vehicles, and property damage
- Control pet to prevent entrance to the Lakeside Park beach area, park buildings, or where posted



PET LICENSE INFORMATION



City ordinance allows a combination of up to 3 cats and/or dogs over 4 months of age per property. Pets must be licensed annually, display a city issued collar tag, and have a valid rabies vaccination.

PET CONTROL INFORMATION

Fines will be issued for pets found in violation of city ordinances. To report a lost, found, or dangerous pet, contact 651-275-4404 or 911. Pets found running at large without a city license or collar tag will be impounded at the Animal Humane Society, 9785 Hudson Road, Woodbury, MN until claimed by the owner.
