City of Bayport DUMPSTER / BULK CONTAINER PERMIT APPLICATION

The city requires a permit for dumpsters and bulk containers, prior to placement on any property within the city. Permits may take up to 5 business days to process, so please plan accordingly. Bulk containers are defined as a receptacle intended for the temporary storage or disposal of bulk materials generated from a special use or project associated with a residential, commercial, or industrial property. Use of bulk containers must comply with the regulations listed below, unless otherwise approved by the city.

- Property owners are responsible for obtaining a bulk container permit from the city, prior to placement
- Containers must be located on private property, at least 5 feet from all property lines
- Containers must be supplied by a city licensed waste hauler or company
- Containers must be sized appropriately to contain all materials and lid must be able to close, if applicable
- Containers are limited to 1 per property; 2 containers allowed for construction of a new residential home
- Containers must be removed within 30 days after issuance of the city permit; 180 days allowed for construction of a new residential home
